

The CAD/CAM Software Hierarchy of Needs is adapted from [Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs](#), which specifies that a design must address lower-level needs before higher-level needs can be addressed.

The original Maslow's needs are shown in parenthesis in the picture below.

An example CAD/CAM software activity for each corresponding need is shown on the right hand side of the picture.

A typical cost-effective goal is to achieve the biggest impact with the least amount of effort. This means using software development as a last resort, since it is very time consuming, expensive, and requires the most resources.
